The USS Emory S. Land is one of two submarine tenders currently operated by the U.S. Navy. She is the lead ship of her class and boasts a crew of 400 sailors. On May 31st the USS Emory S. Land will break the twenty-three-year gap of active and fully crewed US Naval ships to dock at Mare Island after a successful completion of operation AJAX in Hawaii.

Commissioned in 1979, the Emory S. Land has a historic connection with the Bay Area, as her first port of call was Oakland, California in 1979. This is a remarkable event for our community because the last US Naval ship to dock at Mare Island was the USS Los Angeles, a nuclear attack submarine, in March of 1995.
